How much is rent?

Our rental rates are set by federal law. Currently, rent is based on your Income adjusted to allow for dependents, utilities and other items. If your income goes up or down, so will your rent.

Where do I apply for housing?

Our offices are located at 1124 N. 9th in Kansas City, Kansas. Look for the "Tenant Selection" sign next to the high-rise building. We accept applications at this location Monday through Friday.

Do I need to apply in person?

Yes. To make an appointment, please call us at 281-3300 and ask for Resident Selection. You will need to come to our office for an interview and to give us application information.

You will receive a letter offering you an apartment or place on our waiting list. If you are not approved, we'll send you a letter explaining why you are not eligible for the program.
